Check list for your first year:

Vaccinations

■ Vaccine protection based on individual needs and risk of exposure, Rabies vaccine annually

Parasite Prevention

- We recommend intestinal parasite screens regularly in your senior dog
- ☐ Heart worm prevention is essential every 30 days life long
- ☐ Flea prevention is advised every 30 days year round

Senior diagnostic tests

- Wellness blood screen and hormone tests help us monitor how gracefully your pet is aging and detect disease conditions early
- □ Survey x-rays help us detect disease processes early and diagnose arthritis, tumors, heart conditions, etc.
